- Enjoy practical problem-solving
- Like keeping things organised and running smoothly
- Can contribute a little time, either regularly or occasionally
- Have practical, maintenance, facilities, DIY, farming, engineering or similar experience (although enthusiasm matters just as much!)

Not all roles need to be physical. Some tasks involve planning, coordinating, record-keeping, inspections or helping organise maintenance activities.

This is a volunteer team, so there's no expectation that anyone takes on a large commitment. Some people may be available to help regularly, while others might only be able to lend a hand from time to time. Every contribution is valuable and appreciated.
